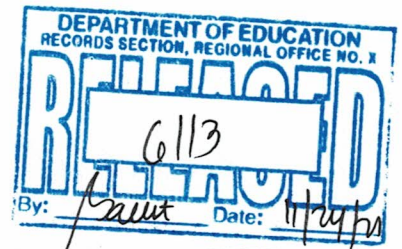


3RD ANNUAL INTRAMUROS YOUNG SCHOLARS CONFERENCE
